This reprogramming action transfers \$14.7 million from Aircraft Procurement, Navy, 00/02, to Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Defense-Wide, 00/01. This action uses general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 106-79, the DoD Appropriations Act, FY 2000, and section 1001 of Public Law 106-65, the National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2000. This action meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress and has not previously been denied by the Congress. This transfer is not reflected in the FY 2001 President's Budget.

Explanation: This action will fully fund the U.S. cost share for the FY 2000 Multifunctional Information Distribution System (MIDS) international cooperative development program. It will also provide continued capability to identify and correct performance deficiencies, and ensure system interoperability for multiple tactical air and ground platforms in the U.S. and NATO force structure. Specifically, the funds will extend the Engineering and Manufacturing Development (EMD) contract with the prime contractor through the end of the fiscal year, upgrade the EMD terminal hardware/software, retrofit EMD terminals to the final configuration, and fund deficiency analyses and corrections.



Explanation: Funds budgeted for Engineering Change Orders (ECOs) in the amount of \$5.8 million are available due to unobligated prior year ECO funding being available to support the FY 2000 requirement. Additionally, due to a delay in the development of the Common Missile Warning System (CMWS), the integration of CMWS into the Integrated Defensive Electronic Countermeasures (IDECM) system is correspondingly delayed, resulting in the availability of \$8.9 million of nonrecurring engineering funds. The rephasing does not affect the multiyear procurement.
