



This reprogramming action transfers \$7.7 million from Drug Interdiction and Counter-Drug Activities, Defense, to Operation and Maintenance, Defense-Wide, FY 2002, for drug interdiction and counter-drug activities consistent with the provisions and authorities enacted under Division B, Title III, Public Law 106-246, the Emergency Supplemental Act, 2000. This transfer authority is in addition to other transfer authorities provided by that Act. Realignment of funds between counter-drug projects may be accomplished only with prior approval of the Office of the Under Secretary of Defense for Policy, Counternarcotics.
