This reprogramming action transfers \$463.0 million from the Iraq Freedom Fund, 04/05, appropriation to the Other Procurement, Army, 04/05, appropriation. These funds will be used to procure items that are considered essential to improving the safety and security of U.S. forces in Iraq. This transfer authority is contained in the Emergency Supplemental Appropriations Act for Defense and for the Reconstruction of Iraq and Afghanistan, 2004, Public Law 108-106.

FY 2004 REPROGRAMMING INCREASES: **+463,000**

Budget Activity 1: Tactical and Support Vehicles

Up-Armored High Mobility Multipurpose Wheeled Vehicle **+301,600**

Explanation: The funds will procure 1,471 Up-Armored High Mobility Multipurpose Wheeled Vehicles (HMMWVs) for operations in Iraq. This procurement is necessary to enhance the survivability of soldiers and vehicles operating in the theater.

Modification of In-Service Equipment **+132,000**

Explanation: Additional funding will procure and install ballistic protection kits for a variety of wheeled vehicles, including High Mobility Multi-Purpose Wheeled Vehicles (HMMWVs), Family of Medium Tactical Vehicles (FMTVs), Heavy Expanded Mobility Tactical Trucks (HEMTTs), Heavy Equipment Transporters (HETs), and the Palletized Load System (PLS).

Budget Activity 2: Communications and Electronics

Night Vision, Thermal Weapon Sight **+29,400**

Explanation: These night vision devices will be issued with, and attached to, the 1,471 new Up-Armored HMMWVs that are being procured with the IFF. These sights will enable effective night operations. They will remain in Iraq as part of the Up-Armored HMMWV operational readiness fleet and will not rotate with the troops.
