**SUBJECT: Interim Change to the DoDFMR, Volume 7A, Regarding
Entitlement to FSA-R (DFAS Item J-41)**

The attached Interim Change 06-01 to Chapter 27 of the Defense Financial Management Regulation (DoDFMR), Volume 7A, is effective immediately. This change clarifies the entitlement to FSA-R when a member elects a dependent restricted tour.

We have evaluated your comments on the proposed change and included them where appropriate. Assignment of the interim change number is your authority to initiate procedural modifications to implement this change. Use the attached to initiate the formal change to the DoDFMR, Volume 7A.

FSA-R

1. **Add the following sentence to paragraph 270301C.1 after the first sentence:**

"A member who is in receipt of accompanied tour orders, and subsequently requests to serve an unaccompanied tour, to include a dependents-restricted tour, in lieu of an accompanied tour at a permanent station where his or her dependents are permitted, is not entitled to FSA-R for such a tour."

2. **In paragraph 270104, replace 274104A.1 with "270104A.1**
3. **In Table 27-3, Rule 22, Column D, replace FAS-IL with, FSA-II."**
4. **In Table 27-3, Add Rule 23,**

Column A, "executes PCS orders causing a separation from the member's spouse."

Column B, "member is married to another active duty member"

Column C, "the couple was residing together immediately before being separated by reason of military orders"

Column D, "member is entitled to FSA-R under the specific rule (note 7)."
