SUBJECT: Department of Defense Financial Management Regulation,
Volume 7A, (DoDFMR, Vol 7A), Servicemen's Group Life
Insurance (DFAS Item F-15)

This is DFAS Interim change number 14-96 to the Department of Defense Financial Management Regulation (DoDFMR) Volume 7, Part A. This change is effective April 1, 1996.

We evaluated your comments on the draft change and included your comments in the attached final version where appropriate. Assignment of an interim change number is your authority to initiate a procedural modification to facilitate this DoDFMR change.

We determined that this policy change is to be implemented under the auspices of DFAS Regulation 7920.3-R. The respective Program Management Office will ensure the necessary system changes are scheduled for implementation consistent with all known requirements. Centers are advised to issue appropriate procedural modifications compatible with the necessary system changes. Centers are advised to make this headquarters an information addressee on implementing field procedures. For the Denver Center, use the attached to initiate the formal printed change to the DoDFMR.

Change the first sentence in paragraph 70403a to read:

"Effective 1 April 1996 this program automatically insures eligible members against death in the amount of \$200,000 when the member is performing active duty or active duty for training for an ordered period of more than 30 days, or while on full-time duty as a cadet or midshipman at a Service academy."

Change the last sentence in paragraph 70403a to read:

"Members may elect coverage for an amount less than \$200,000, in \$10,000 increments, or may elect to waive coverage."

Delete paragraph 70403b.

Change paragraph 70403c to 70403b.

Change Rule 1, Column B, **Table 7-4-1** to read:

"coverage is the first day of entry on such duty (note 2). Maximum basic coverage is automatically in effect until the member elects reduced coverage or waives coverage (note 3)."

Delete last sentence, Rule 2, Column B.

Change Rule 4, Column A, to read:

"applies for increase or reinstatement of coverage after entry on such duty."

Change Rule 8, Column B, to read:

"coverage is the first day of active duty (maximum basic coverage is automatic unless a member applies for reduced or no coverage)."

Change Note 5 to read:

"Any previous election not to be insured or to be insured for less than \$200,000 is cancelled. Maximum basic coverage is automatically in effect unless the member again elects not to be insured or to be insured in a reduced amount."

Change Note 7 to read:

"Increase or reinstatement of coverage is contingent upon written application by the member on DVA Form SGLV 8285, Request for Insurance, and approval by the OSGLI."

Change the first and second sentences of paragraph 80362a to read:

"a. Basic Coverage. Effective 1 April 1996, this program automatically insures eligible members against death in the amount of \$200,000 while the member is performing active duty or active duty for training for an ordered period of 30 days or less, or is performing inactive duty training. Members may elect coverage for less than \$200,000, in \$10,000 increments or may elect to decline coverage."

Delete paragraph 80362b.

Change paragraph 80362c to paragraph 80362b.

Change "SSGLI" in new paragraph 80362b to "SGLI."

Change paragraph 80362d to paragraph 80362c.
