

DEFENSE SOFTWARE REPOSITORY SYSTEM

The Defense Software Repository System (DSRS) is a network of Software Reuse Support Centers (SRSCs) providing an automated library of reusable asset for storage and retrieval. Current sites include a DISA central site and six remote SRSCs. The DISA site is located in Falls Church, VA. The remote centers include:

- Army Reuse Center, Falls Church, VA
- Air Force DSRS, Montgomery, AL
- Defense Logistics Agency, Columbus, OH
- Marine Corps Software Reuse Branch, Quantico, VA
- Navy Software Reuse Support Center, Cheltenham, MD
- National Security Agency DSRS, Fort Meade, MD

The DSRS is the responsibility of the Defense Information Systems Agency/Joint Interoperability and Engineering Organization/Center for Information Management Software Reuse Program (SRP). The SRP is dedicated to promoting and supporting software reuse within the DoD Information Management community.

The DSRS offers developers the opportunity to find reusable assets that can shorten development time by matching project requirements. A reusable asset may be virtually any product such as requirements, design specifications, architectures, design diagrams, source code, documentation, and test suites generated during a software development project. Although primarily utilized to support the reuse and development of Ada software assets, the DSRS also supports storage and retrieval of any reusable asset developed in support of the software life-cycle and reuse. Commercial, defense, federal government, and public domain categories of reusable assets are all available through the DSRS.

The DSRS at the central site contains more than 3800 reusable assets. DSRS accounts are available for Government employees and contractor personnel currently supporting Government projects.
